

our referral process

As soon as we receive the referral we will begin the process of gathering the information that we need to put a curriculum together for the young person.

An interview between the young person, the parents/carers and the referrer will be arranged within 5 working days and a timetable and start date will be agreed.

The young person will be invited to attend an induction period and a review will be held after two weeks.

- A key person will communicate with you regarding the progress the young person is making.
- You will receive weekly and half-termly attendance figures and reports.
- You will be invited to regular interviews.
- A qualified and experienced Teacher will lead the curriculum package for each young person.
- We will use the support of our in-house psychologist and counsellor to support our delivery.
- Behaviour plans, risk assessments and daily recording sheets will show how behaviour has changed.
- Individual learning journeys will show what has been learnt.
